# **FLEX TEACHERS**

- Assist students from all teams who need additional support
- One core content area teacher per grade & one Spanish
- Each teacher is available during Wolf Time Mon-Thu
- Teachers will determine which students need days with a Flex teacher based on classroom and assessment performance and will be assigned to go to the Flex teacher for a specified period of time
- Students may also request time with a Flex teacher if s/he feels specific support is needed

- Opportunity to provide some re-teaching
- Additional layer of academic support

# **Block Instruction Pilot Results**

- Less transitions for students
- More time and opportunities for differentiation and personalized learning
- Increased depth of understanding through more hands on experiences
- Students report less homework and more time to finish what has been assigned
- Staff reports not feeling rushed when delivering instruction
